This request is made pursuant to Rule 104 of the Statewide Rules of New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission. Summit Energy, Inc., (Summit) and Gulf Oil Corporation (Gulf) are the working interest owners in the subject proration unit, each having a fifty (50%) percent interest. This unit was established by a gas pooling agreement dated July 6, 1956. Summit, as operator, is presently producing an average of 98Mcfgpd from the unit through the Drinkard Estate #4 Well. All of the gas is produced from within the vertical limits of the Blinebry Oil & Gas Pool. Prior inquiry to your staff indicated this rate of production would not be affected by this proposed reduction in pooled acreage.

Summit and Gulf hereby request that the pooled unit be reduced to eighty (80) acres comprising the S/2 of the NE/4 referenced above. Summit would be the one hundred (100%) percent working interest owner in the reduced unit. The Drinkard Estate #4 was drilled at an orthodox location. Gulf will be the offset operator in the N/2 of the NE/4 of said section and both Gulf and Summit will be the offset operators in the N/2 of the SE/4 of said section.

It is Gulf's intention to drill 2 Blinebry oil wells in the acreage removed from this unit.
