DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran and cemented 8-5/8" 10-V Thread 36# casing in a 11" hole at depth of 2800' with 400 sacks of regular cement. Plug was pumped down at 10:35 P.M. April 22, 1953. Released pressure after 12 hours and ran temperature survey. Found top of cement; outside casing; at 1850'. At end of 36 hours pressure tested casing with 1000# for 30 minutes. Pressure held without any decline for full 30 minutes. Before well is completed we will set a retainer at base of Rustler Anhydrite and perforate 8-5/8" casing in lower part of Anhydrite then cement through perforations and circulate cement behind 8-5/8" casing to surface.
