Gentlemen:

Comes now Skelly Oil Company a Delaware Corporation with offices in Tulsa, Oklahoma and Hobbs, New Mexico, hereby petitioning the secretary of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for administrative approval for an exception to Order No. R-610 as pertaining to the flaring of gas in the Blinebry Oil Pool, Lea County, New Mexico; and in support thereof wishes to make the following statements:

1. That the petitioner is the operator of a 160 acre lease known as its Baker "C" Lease, located in the NE/4, NE/4 of Section 26 - T 22 S - R 37 E .

2. That the petitioner is the operator of the well listed below.

3. That due to the small amount of gas produced it is not economical to install a casinghead gas connection at this time.

4. That a plat showing offset ownership, well location and tank battery location has been prepared and is correct to the best of our knowledge.

5. That all provisions of paragraph 10, Order No. R-520 have been complied with as to the filing of form C-110 on the well listed above.

WHEREFORE, the petitioner requests that the secretary of the commission grant an exception to Order No. R-610, whereby the petitioner may flare gas from the above well as long as it is not economical to obtain a casinghead gas connection.
