TD-3610'. Well shot with 340 qts SHG from 3525' to 3600' and blank anchor 3600' to 3610'. Shot tamped with approx. three yards gravel. Shot exploded on time and hole bridged itself. April 10th to May 8th spent cleaning out. Was necessary to pull tubing twice due to hole re-caving. Two inch tubing set at 3575', Packer set at 3292'. 5-12-37, Well flowed 76 bbls in 12 hours thru 18/64 choke with GP # and TP 100. While cleaning out, gas estimated 600 M.
