On November 5th there was mailed to you Form C-102 in duplicate, Notice of Intention to Test Casing Shut-off on 152" on our No. 1 Annie L. Christmas located in the NE/4 of the NE/4 of the SE/4, Section 28-22-37, Lea County. As we were in error in not sending you this form in triplicate, we are enclosing a third copy for your approval and trust that you will return one of these for our files as soon as possible.

We are also enclosing in triplicate Form C-103, Report on Result of Test of Casing Shut-off on the $15\frac{1}{8}$ in the above described well.

Also enclosed in triplicate Form C-102, Notice of Intention to Test Casing Shut-off on $8\frac{1}{4}$ to be set at approximately 1100 feet in this same well.

I wish that you would advise at your earliest convenience if it is necessary to file Form C-102 and Form C-103 on intermediate strings run in standard tool holes to merely handle caves and which are not cemented and which will be later pulled. For example we have run 309 feet of 13 3/8" 0.D. casing and plan to run approximately 700 feet of 10" casing neither of which will be cemented. Both of these strings will be pulled after running the 84", but before it is cemented.
