DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 124 feet 15½" 70# S. H. Lapweld casing and attempted to establish circulation 11/9/36. Due to quick sand circulation could not be made by Halliburton. Drilled hole to 309 feet where 13 3/8" 45# new Lapweld casing was run to shut-off a cave. 2" tubing was then run between 13 3/8" and 15½" and circulation was forced behind 15½" and this string was then cemented by Halliburton with 150 sacks cement. Job completed 8 p.m. 11/11/36. Allowed to stand 36 hours and shut off by 15½" O. K.
