Dear Jack:

This is in regard to the casing program of the Repollo
A. L. Christmas Well #1, in Sec. 28, T. 22 S., R. 37 E.

Form C-101, "Notice of Intention to Drill" for the above-
mentioned well which I approved February 8, 1936, had the fol-
lowing casing program: 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing to be set 15' into the red
beds and cemented with 275 sacks; 9" casing to be set at 2900'
and cemented with 650 sacks; 7" casing to be set at 3475' and
cemented with 350 sacks.

From the information I gathered in the field, the 8 5/8"
casing was set at 1116' with 65 sacks and the 7" casing was
set at 3350' with 50 sacks of cement. There was some other
surface casing set but not cemented. Please advise me what
precaution has been taken to confine all waters into the strata
in which they were originally found.

Your prompt attention to this matter will be greatly
appreciated.

This is in regard to the casing program of the Rebollo
A. L. Christmas Well #1, in Sec. 28, T. 22 S., R. 37 E.

Form G-100, "Notice of Intention to Drill" for the above-
mentioned well which I approved February 8, 1938, had the fol-
lowing casing program: 15 1/2" casing to be set 15' into the red
beds and cemented with 575 sacks; 8" casing to be set at 2800'
and cemented with 650 sacks; 7" casing to be set at 3475' and
cemented with 350 sacks.

From the information I gathered in the field, the 8 5/8"
casing was set at 1110' with 65 sacks and the 7" casing was
set at 3250' with 50 sacks of cement. There was some other
surface casing set but not cemented. Please advise me what
precaution has been taken to confine all waters into the strata
in which they were originally found.

Your prompt attention to this matter will be greatly
appreciated.
