Gentlemen:

By form letter dated July 31, 1957, The Texas Company was notified by Mr. R. F. Montgomery that in order to comply with Order R-553 it must obtain a connection for the sale of casinghead gas or secure a no-flare order from the Commission for its State of New Mexico "CD" Well No. 1. This action must be taken not later than October 25, 1957.

The State of New Mexico "CD" Lease contains 40 acres and is comprised of the NW/4 of the NW/4 of Section 28, T-22-S, R-37E, Lea County, New Mexico. The attached plat was prepared to show the location of Well No. 1, offset ownership, and the location of the tank battery. The Texas Company is in the process of negotiating a contract with Skelly Oil Company to take the 131.8 MCF of casinghead gas per day now being produced and flared by Well No. 1, which has a limited capacity of 18 barrels of oil per day and a gas-oil ratio of 7322 cubic feet per barrel, based on Gas-Oil Ratio test dated October 4, 1957. It is anticipated that it will require approximately 90 days to complete a contract with Skelly and secure a connection for this well. Therefore, a temporary no-flare order for a period of three months commencing October 25, 1957, is respectfully requested for the State of New Mexico "CD" Well No. 1.
