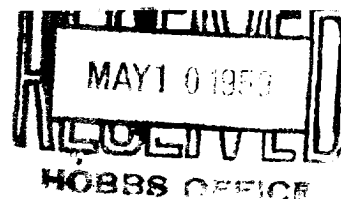

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We propose to do the following:

- (1) Run Tubing to 6550' - Total Depth
- (2) Load hole with 9½ and 10 pound Mud
- (3) Set 200 foot cement plug (20 sacks) from 6350' to 6550'
- (4) Shoot 8-5/8" casing at 1904'
- (5) Pull 8-5/8" casing out at 1904'
- (6) Set 200 foot cement plug (20 sacks) at 2000' to 2200'
- (7) Set 50 foot cement plug at surface - 50' to surface
- (8) Place 4 foot marker on surface, set in concrete
Marker to be of steel, 4 inches in diameter.
