Gentlemen:

Aztec Oil & Gas Company hereby makes application for administrative approval for an exception to Rule 1 of Order R-610 of the Special Rules for the Blinebry Oil Pool as pertaining to the flaring of casinghead gas in the Blinebry Oil Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, states the following facts:

(1) That Aztec Oil & Gas Company is the joint owner and designated operator of a dual oil well, known as the State "BD-36" well No. 1 in the Blinebry Oil Pool, located 1980 feet from the South and East lines of Section 36, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. This well is being dualled with the Drinkard at the present time.

(2) That the subject well started producing oil from the Blinebry Oil Pool on June 1, 1958. The gravity of the produced oil is 40° API. All gas, or about 300 MCF per day, is presently being flared awaiting a gas connection by Skelly Oil Company.

(3) That the subject well has no connection for sale of gas at this time, but it is expected that Skelly Oil Company will make such a connection by October 15, 1958, (see attached copy of Skelly's letter). Skelly Oil Company has been delayed in connecting due to right-of-way troubles.


(4) A copy of this application is herewith furnished all offset operators.

In view of the facts stated herein, Aztec Oil & Gas Company requests the Secretary of the Commission to grant within 15 days an exception to Order R-610 whereby the petitioners may operate the State "BD-36" well No. 1 in the Blinebry Oil Pool until such time as actual connection has been made for disposition of the casinghead gas. This exception is requested from September 1, 1958, until connection which is expected by October 15, 1958.
