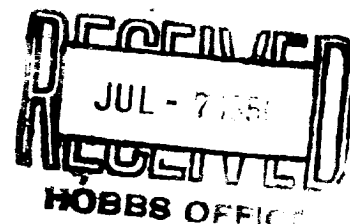

T.D. 3600', 5½" Casing set at 3600', 5½" Casing perforations 3581' to 3991' & 3280' to 3320'

Because of a high water-oil ratio on this well it is our intention to squeeze off with cement the perforations from 3581' to 3591'. We then plan to re-perforate the 5½" casing with 4 shots per foot from 3560' to 3571' and acidise with 500 gallons of 15% low tension acid. Production test will be taken and if satisfactory the well will be placed back on production.

Perforated 5½" Casing with Lane-Wells Gun from 3280' to 3320' with 4 shots per foot. Total of 160 shots. Acidised with 500 gallons of Western 15% Low Tension Acid. Max. Press. 2800#. Pulled and re-ran tubing with three (3) Olseo Flow Valves set at 2381', 3121' & 3496'. In 24 hours on open 2" choke the well flowed 17.98 bbls. of oil and 650.00 bbls. of water. Gas Volume 1,050,000 cu ft per day. GFR 1550
