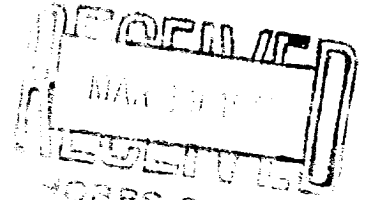

Washed acid slowly over Perf. in 5 1/2" Csg. from 3581' to 3591' Treatment complete @ 9:20 P.M. Removed Xmas Tree & Set Packer @ 3492' Tbg. set @ 3592', Tested Packer w/600# was O.K. Rigged up & started swabbing @ 11:30 P.M. Pulled swab 4 times & Well Kicked off. Turned to tanks on 3/4" Choke, made 419.70 bbls. fluid, 109.80 bbls. oil, & 309.90 bbls. Water. Gas Volume 104,000 Cu Ft. Gas per day. G.F.R. 247 Well Completed.
