DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total PB Depth 3706', Lime. 5-1/2" casing cemented at 3624'.

After setting retainer at 3705' and squeezing 41 sacks of cement into formation from 3705' to 3740' to plug off water, this well produced 182 barrels fluid, 11% BS&W, in 24 hours swabbing. After acidizing 10-18-43 with 1000 gallons, using blanket from 3684' to 3706' to prevent acid from going around plug-back into water, the well produced 276 barrels oil plus 7% water in 12 hours flowing through open 2" tubing, with a Gas/Oil Ratio of 712 cu. ft./bbl.

After setting a retainer at 3705' and squeezing 41 sacks of cement into formation from 3705 to 3740' to plug off water, this well produced 182 barrels fluid, 11% BS&W, in 24 hours swabbing. We desire permission to acidize with approximately 1000 gallons from 3625 to 3684' in an effort to increase production and make the well flow, using blanket from 3684' to 3706' to prevent acid from going around plug-back into water.
