FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK  
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

The Farney A-17 No. 1 was completed at a total depth of 3695' on 11-9-57. The well was perforated in the Yates formation, 3672-86'. On April 10, 1960 this well tested 8 BO, 0 BW w/33 MCFGPD in 24 hrs.

We propose to perforate the Yates 3576-82', 3618-3630', 3650-56' w/4 JSPP, run 2-1/2" tubing w/treating Pkr set above 3620', sandfrac w/12,000 gals. of lease crude, 24,000 lbs. sand, 600 lbs. Adomite in 3 stages w/50 ball sealers between stages and spearheaded by 1,500 gals. 15% LSTNE acid. Circulate out sand, pull tubing, run 2" tubing and return well to production.
