

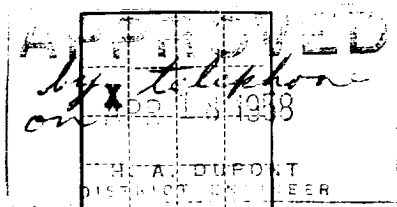

### DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill this well with rotary tools at the above location to an estimated TD of 3900'. Casing will be cemented in accordance with U.S.C.S. standards and other special requirements will be complied with.

The following casing pattern is planned: 8 5/8" OD set at 350' with 250 sacks, cement to circulate; 5 1/2" OD set at 3900' with 1100 sacks, cement to return to 1600'.

Permission is requested to produce this well upon completion.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
