FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We cemented 7200' of 7" O.P. 23# casing with 350 sacks on October 31, 1945. Plug was pumped down at 1:20 P. M.

Cement will be allowed 72 hours in which to set and then will be drilled to a depth of approximately 7165'. Casing will be pressure tested and then gun-perforated from 7040' to 7160' with four shots per foot after mud has been displaced from casing with water. Packer will then be run on tubing above a depth of 7040' and the hole will be swabbed for natural production. After this test we plan to acidize through casing perforations.
