> RE: WELLBORE COMMINGLING C. H. Lockhart Fed (NCT-1) No. 7 Blinebry and Drinkard Pools Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

TEXACO INC. requests administrative approval to commingle in the wellbore oil production from the Blinebry and Drinkard Pools in Well No. 7 on the C. H. Lockhart Federal (NCT-1) Lease located in Section 18, Township 22 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

The subject well is a single completion in the Drinkard Pool. Upon approval of this application the Blinebry formation will be opened and commingled with the Drinkard. The fluids from these two reservoirs are commingled on surface and are known to be compatible. Ownership of the minerals in both zones is common, and the value of the commingled fluids is not less than the total value of the fluids if they were marketed separately. Secondary operations will not be jeopardized by approval of this application.

A data sheet is attached listing all required data for the two reservoirs. Also attached is a production decline curve for the Drinkard zone, a sketch of the present and proposed completion, location plat, C-116 and a list of offset operators.

A copy of this application is being mailed to each of the offset operators shown on the attached list.
