Gentlemen:

By this letter of application The Texas Company wishes to state the following:

- (a) That The Texas Company's A. H. Blinebry (NCT-1) Well No. 1, located in the SW/4 SE/4, Section 19, T-22-S, R-37-E, is to be completed at an approximate plugback total depth of 6305 feet. The attached Exhibit "A" shows the location of the subject well in the A. H. Blinebry (NCT-1) Lease with the location of all offset wells. The attached Exhibit "B" shows diagrammatically a sketch of the proposed dual completion.
- (b) That the subject well has 7-inch casing set at 5673' and cemented with 350 sacks of cement into which it is anticipated that approximately 605' of 5½" liner will be hung. The 5½" liner will be set with its bottom at 6255' and will be cemented with 200 sacks of neat cement. The well is presently producing from the Blinebry Gas Pool through the perforated interval from 5580 to 5625'. The Tubb Gas Pool will be opened to production through perforations in the 5½" liner from approximately 5095' to 6175'.
- (c) That the applicant proposes to dually complete the well in the following manner:
 - 1. Set a production retainer packer at approximately 5640' in the 7-inch casing to separate the Blinebry and Tubb gas reservoirs.

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2. Using a single string of tubing be run through and sealed within production packer, produce the Blinebry Gas Pool gas through the tubing and the casing-tubing liner.
- (d) That the granting of this application is to produce the well as a dual completion from the Blinebry Gas Pool and gas from Pool is in the interest of conservation and protection of correlative rights.
- (e) That the applicant will comply with all regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.
- (f) That the manner and method of the proposed dual completion is mechanically feasible and practical.
- (g) By copy of this letter of application, all offset operators are notified by registered mail of the proposed dual completion.
