APPLICATION TO DUALY COMPLETE
The Texas Company's A. H. Blinebry
(NCT-1) Well No. 7, Blinebry Gas
Pool and Tubb Gas Pool, Lea County

Gentlemen:

By this letter of application, The Texas Company wishes to state the following:

- (a) That The Texas Company's A. H. Blinebry (NCT-1) Well No. 7, located in the G, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 19-22S-38E, has been completed at a plugged back total depth of 6252 feet. The attached Exhibit "A" shows the location of the subject well on the A. H. Blinebry (NCT-1) Lease with the location of all offset wells. The attached Exhibit "B" shows a diagrammatic sketch of the proposed dual completion.
- (b) That the subject well has seven inch casing set at 6250 feet and cemented with 500 sacks of cement which extends behind the pipe to 2960 feet. The well is to be a gas-gas dual well having open the interval 6120 to 6200 feet from the Tubb formation in the Tubb Pool, and the interval 5558 to 5688 feet from the Blinebry formation in the Blinebry Gas Pool
- (c) That the applicant proposes to dually complete the well in the following manner:
 1. Set production type packer below the upper perforations at approximately 6090 feet to separate the two pay zones.
 2. Produce the Tubb Gas Pool gas through the tubing and the Blinebry Gas Pool gas through the tubing-casing annulus.

- (d) That the granting of this application for permission to produce the well as a dual completion with gas from the Blinebry Gas Pool and gas from the Tubb Gas Pool is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.
- (e) That the applicant will comply with all rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.
- (f) That the manner and method of the proposed dual completion is mechanically feasible and practical.
- (g) That by copy of this letter of application, all offset operators are notified by registered mail of the proposed dual completion.

Therefore, The Texas Company requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant permission to dually complete the subject well as proposed in this application.

By this letter The Texas Company is requesting letters of waiver waiving objection to the proposed dual completion, from all offset operators. It is requested that these letters, in duplicate, be submitted to The Texas Company, Box 1780, Fort Worth, Texas.

It is respectfully requested that upon receipt of the above requested letters of waiver in their Santa Fe office, the Commission waive the 10-day waiting period requirements as provided in Order No. R-316 Rule 112-A.




- Blinebry Gas Unit (160 Ac.)
