On July 4th the **13 3/8" O.D. 49 1/2 Rmd. Thd. S.S. Casing** was set at **305'** in Red Bed. Cemented by Halliburton method with **300 sacks bulk cement**, cement circulated and plug pumped to **285'**. Job completed at **12 O'clock Noon July 4, 1945.**

**Propose to drill plug and test shut off at Noon on July 6, 1945.**
