Gulf Oil requests your administrative approval for a 80 acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool, to be dedicated to our Watkins No. 1 well, located 660' FSL and 1980' FEL, Section 29, 22-S, 38-E, covering the S/2 SE/4 of said Section.

In support of this application the following facts are submitted:

1. Subject well was reclassified, effective January 1, 1972 as a gas well in the Blinebry Gas Pool, due to Gas-Oil ratio in excess of 32,000/l, necessitating this non-standard unit.
2. Applicants well No. 2, located in the SE/4 SE/4, Section 29, 22-S, 38-E, is a marginal Blinebry oil well and will be closed in upon approval of this application.
3. The attached plat show the proposed 80 acre non-standard unit outlined in red.
4. The non-standard unit lies wholly within a governmental quarter section.
5. All offset operators have been furnished a copy of this application.

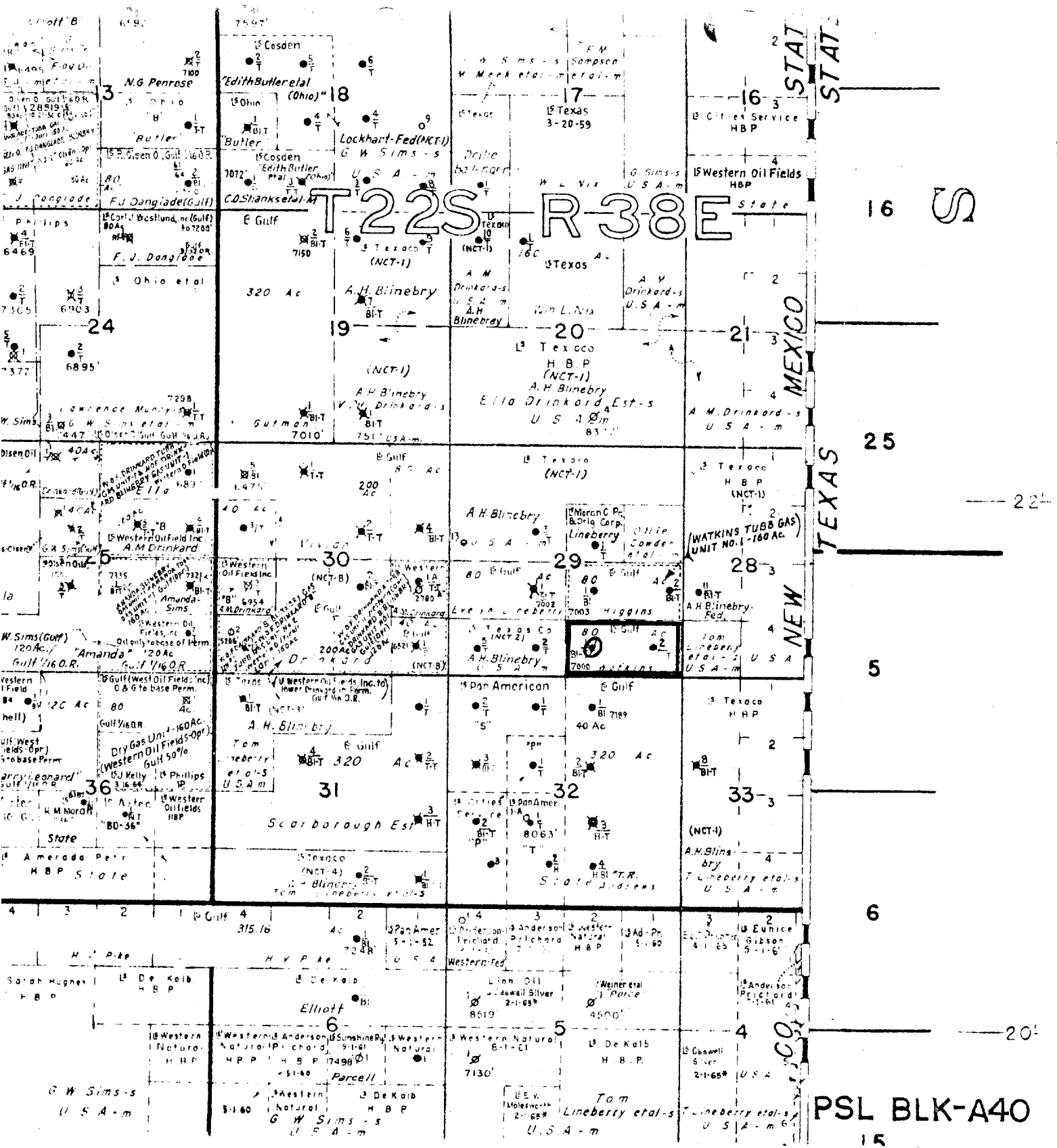
