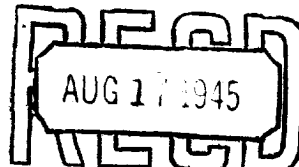

On August 10, 1945 the 7" O.D. Casing was cemented in Line at 6,901' with 575 sacks of 2½ Aquagel and 125 sacks of neat cement by Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company. The plug was pumped to 6,872'. Job started at 10:00 A.M. and completed at 10:00 P.M. August 10, 1945.

7" O.D. Casing as follows:

45 Jts. 23½ 8 Bnd. Thd. New National N-80 S. S. Casing on bottom, 1,434'.
174 Jts. 23½ 8 Bnd. Thd. New National J-85 S.S. Casing 5,467'.
(Total Tallies 6,891' - Cellar 10'.)

Propose to drill plug and test shut off at 10:00 P.M. August 13, 1945.
