Gulf's Allen No. 1, Unit "J", 30-22S-38E, Drinkard Pool

Please refer to our Form C-110, Authorization to Transport Oil, on the Allen No. 1, approved July 15, 1946 by the Conservation Commission. Under "Remarks" you will note that Allen No. 1 was to be produced into the Drinkard "B" tank battery, and the unitized battery was known as Drinkard "B" and Allen tank battery.

This is to inform you that, effective at once, the Allen No. 1 will be known as Drinkard "B" No. 2; and the tank battery will be known as "Drinkard "B" Tank Battery". The Allen No. 1 will appear in the October Proration Schedule as Drinkard "B" No. 2.

Following the advice of Mr. Trout, of your office, this letter is to inform you of this change; and to inform Texas-New Mexico Pipe Line Co. that the run ticket will be headed "Drinkard "B" Lease", in the future. The Proration Office has been notified of the change effective with the October schedule.
