DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On July 1, 1946, attempted to acidize with 2000 gal by Chemical Process, pumped 570 gal into formation in 6 hours. Production before, swabbed dry; production after, swabbed dry.

On July 3, 1946, acidized with 1000 gallons by Chemical Process, duration of treatment 1 hour and 20 minutes. Production before, swabbed dry; production after, swabbed at rate of 2 barrels of clean oil per hour.
