On September 23, 1945 the 9 5/8" O.D. 8 Rnd. Thd. 36# Grade H-40 Range 2 S. S. Casing was set in Anhydrite at 2,922' and cemented by Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company with 1200 sacks of 2# Aquagel and 100 sacks of Neat Cement. The plug was pumped to 2,891'. The job was started at 5:00 A.M. and completed at 1:00 P.M. September 23rd.

We propose to drill plug and test shut off at 1:00 P. M. Sept. 25, 1945.
