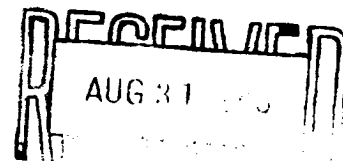

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The hole was washed down and the casing tested with 1200# pressure applied for 30 minutes. The plug was drilled and the hole tested with 1200# pressure applied for 30 minutes. Both tests were OK, and after approval of Mr. Roy Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.

Temperature survey shows top of cement behind 9-5/8" casing at 1275' from surface.
