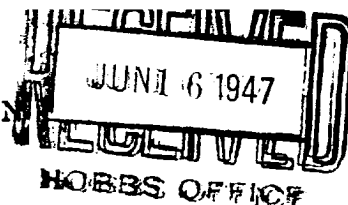

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On June 13, 1947 the 9 5/8" OD new 36#, 8 RT casing was set at 2925' anhydrite. Cemented with 1200 sacks 2% and 100 sacks Neat Bulk Cement by Halliburton method. Plug pumped to 2890'. Job started 12:15 PM; completed 8:45 PM June 13, 1947.

Purpose to drill plug and test shut-off at 8:45 PM June 14, 1947.
