Re: Application to dually complete Western Oilfields Inc's Gulf Drinkard #1, Drinkard Oil Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Gentlemen:

By means of this application Western Oilfields Inc. wishes to state the following:

1. That Western Oilfields Inc's Gulf Drinkard #1 well is located 660 feet North of the South Line and 660 feet East of the West Line of Sec. 30, T-22-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico.
2. That the petitioner (Western Oilfields Inc) will complete the well in the manner described below.
 - A. Perforate the Drinkard Oil Zone within the interval 6200 to 6920 for Drinkard Oil.
 - B. Perforate the Blinbry Gas Zone within the interval 5400 and 5500 for Blinbry Gas.
 - C. Set a Baker Model "D" Retainer Production Packoff at a depth of 6050 to segregate the two producing horizons.
 - D. Produce the Drinkard Oil through 2" tubing and the Blinbry Gas through the tubing-casing annulus.
3. That the manner and method of dually completing, which is shown in the attached diagrammatic sketch marked Exhibit "A" is mechanically feasible and will prevent commingling of fluids and gases from the two reservoirs.
4. That notification has been sent to all operators of leases directly or diagonally abutting the said Gulf Drinkard Lease of the applicant as required by New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rule 112AA for Dual completions.

It is therefore respectfully requested that the Conservation Commission grant the applicant permission to dually complete the Gulf Drinkard #1 well in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Commission.

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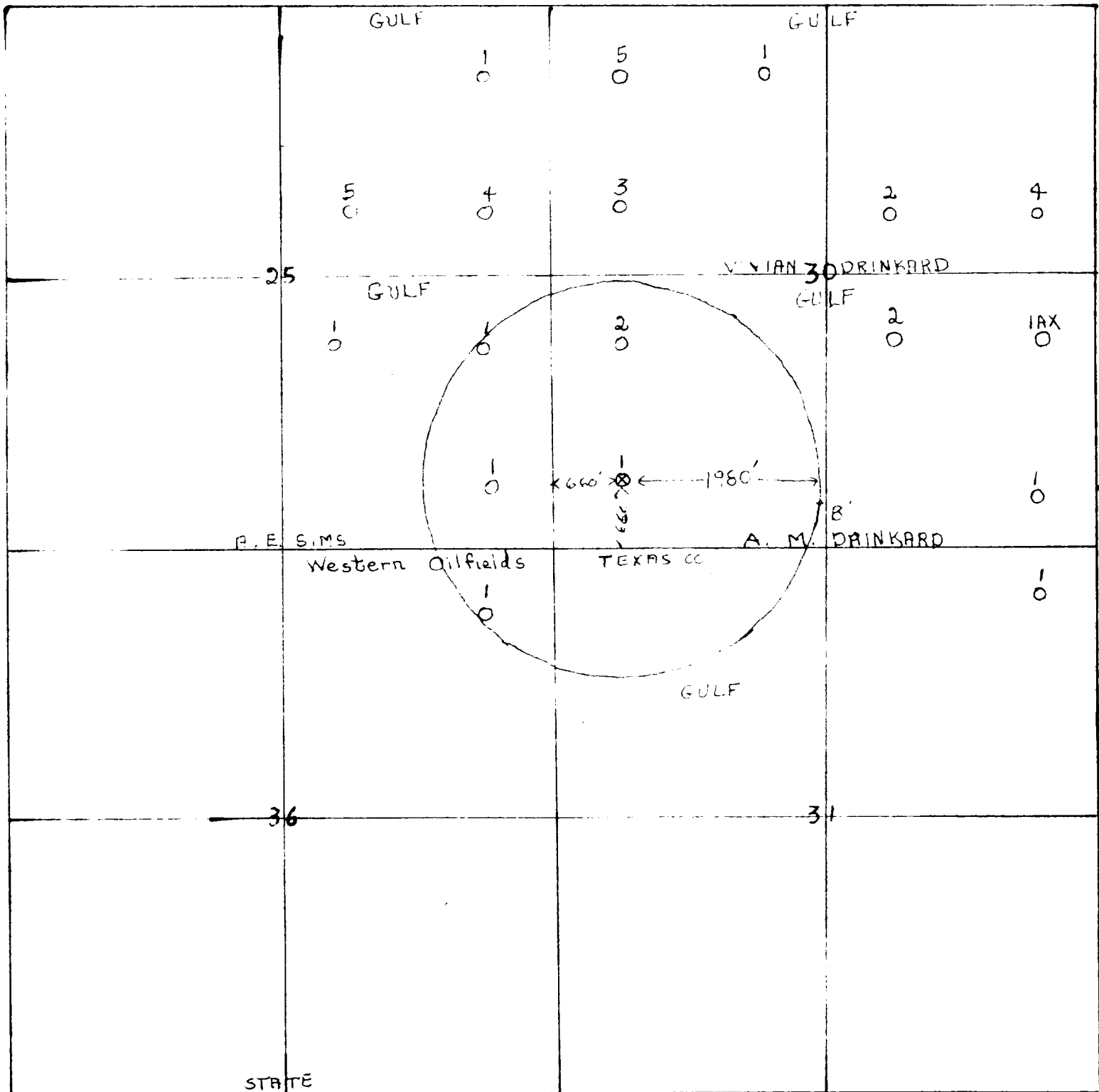
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SECTION 30 TOWNSHIP 22 S RANGE 38 E COUNTY LEA STATE NEW MEXICO
