DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Drilled 11" hole to depth of 2840', in Brown Dolomite, then ran Caliper survey. Ran 8-5/8" 32# H 40 casing to bottom and cemented with 1062 sacks of 6% jel cement. Pumped plug down at 5:55 P.M. November 1, 1951 and circulated approximately 25 sacks back in to cellar.

Went in hole November 4, 1951 (after allowing cement a set time of 72 hours) and pressure tested casing with 750#. Found cement job to be OK. Drilled plug and continued drilling.
