FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Original notice to drill and subsequent operational reports on this well were filed and designated the Drinkard #1A, located at location given above. Hole was drilled to 2780', total depth, and 8-5/8" second-hand 24" casing was run. On cementing with 1600 sax of 3% aquagel and 100 sax of regular cement, casing split and cement circulated to cellar. This was on March 5, 1951. Subsequent attempts to salvage this effort were useless, and it was decided to skid the rig and location 60 ft. north, and re-commence the well. Verbal report and confirmation of this plan was made and obtained from the Commission office at Hobbs, and rig was skidded on March 20, 1951.

New hole to be designated Well No. 1-A-X.
