Re: Application to dually complete Western Oilfields Inc. Drinkard #2, Drinkard
Oil Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Gentlemen:

By means of this application Western Oilfields Inc. wishes to state the following:
1. That Western Oilfields Inc. Drinkard #2 is located 1080 feet north of the south line, and 660 feet east of the west line of Sec. 30, T-22S, R-38E, Lea County, New Mexico. The Drinkard #2 well was originally drilled to T.D. of 6054' with 7" casing set at 5407' and 5" casing liner from 5377' to 6775'. A bridging plug was set at 6330' and perforations were affected 6060' to 6075' opposite the Tubbs gas pay, and Tubbs gas has been produced in this manner since 1952.

2. That the petitioner (Western Oilfields Inc.) will complete the well in the following described manner.

- A. Drill out the bridging plug set at 6330'.
- B. Set Baker Model "D" Production packer at a depth of 6200 feet to segregate the producing zones.
- C. Produce the Drinkard oil through 2" tubing from open hole section 6775' to 6954' and the Tubbs gas through the tubing casing annulus, from casing perforation 6060' to 6075'.

3. That the manner and method of dually completing, which is shown in the attached diagrammatic sketch marked Exhibit "A" is mechanically feasible and will prevent commingling of fluids and gases from the two reservoirs.

4. That notification has been sent to all operators directly or diagonally off setting the said Western Oilfields Drinkard Lease as required by New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rule 112-A for dual completions.

It is therefore respectfully requested that the Conservation Commission grant the applicant permission to dually complete the Drinkard #2 well in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Commission.
