Gentlemen:

In compliance with Rule 30, Order No. R-1670, which prohibits the simultaneous dedication of acreage to an oil and to a gas well, Gulf Oil Corporation respectfully requests exception to Rule 5(a) of Order No. R-1670 for the approval of a non-standard 120-acre Blinebry gas proration unit covering the N/2 SW/4 and the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 31, Township 22 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico. In support of this application, the following facts are submitted:

- (1) Gulf's Scarborough Estate Well No. 4, located 1980 feet from the north line and 1980 feet from the west line of Section 31 is completed in the Blinebry Gas Pool and has been assigned a non-standard 160-acre gas proration unit covering the N/2 SW/4, SE/4 NW/4 and the NW/4 SE/4.
- (2) Gulf's Scarborough Estate Well No. 5, located 1980 feet from the south line and 1980 feet from the east line of this Section 31 has been recompleted as a Blinebry oil well.
- (3) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections, but does not lie wholly within a single governmental quarter section.
- (4) The entire non-standard proration unit is reasonably presumed to be gas productive in the Blinebry Gas Pool.
- (5) The length or width does not exceed 2640 feet.
