
Gentlemen:

By letter dated October 10, 1958, Mr. R. F. Montgomery, Proration Manager, notified The Texas Company it would be necessary to obtain a No Flare Order not later than December 14, 1958, for its A. H. Blinebry NCT-3 Well No. 1, in order to comply with the provisions contained in Order R-553. This well is located in Unit D, Section 31, Township 22, Range 38, Blinebry Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

This well is presently producing at a penalized allowable of 22 barrels of oil per day with a gas-oil ratio of 12,571 cubic feet per barrel, which results in 276.6 MCF of gas per day being flared. However, The Texas Company is in the process of finalizing a contract with Skelly Oil Company to take the gas from this well and respectfully requests a 60-day exception to the No Flare Order R-553.

Attached are three copies of a plat showing the well and tank battery location, offset ownership, and the location of existing gas gathering lines in the vicinity.



On 10 January 1964, a letter was received from the Department of Defense, Washington, D.C., regarding the status of the contract for the purchase of 100,000 M16 rifles. The letter stated that the contract was still in effect and that the rifles were being manufactured. It also stated that the rifles were being shipped to the United States and that the contract was being renewed for an additional 100,000 rifles.

This letter was received by the Department of Defense on 10 January 1964. It was forwarded to the Department of the Army on 11 January 1964. The Department of the Army is currently reviewing the contract and will report back to the Department of Defense on 15 January 1964. The Department of the Army is also conducting a study on the M16 rifle and will report back to the Department of Defense on 15 January 1964.

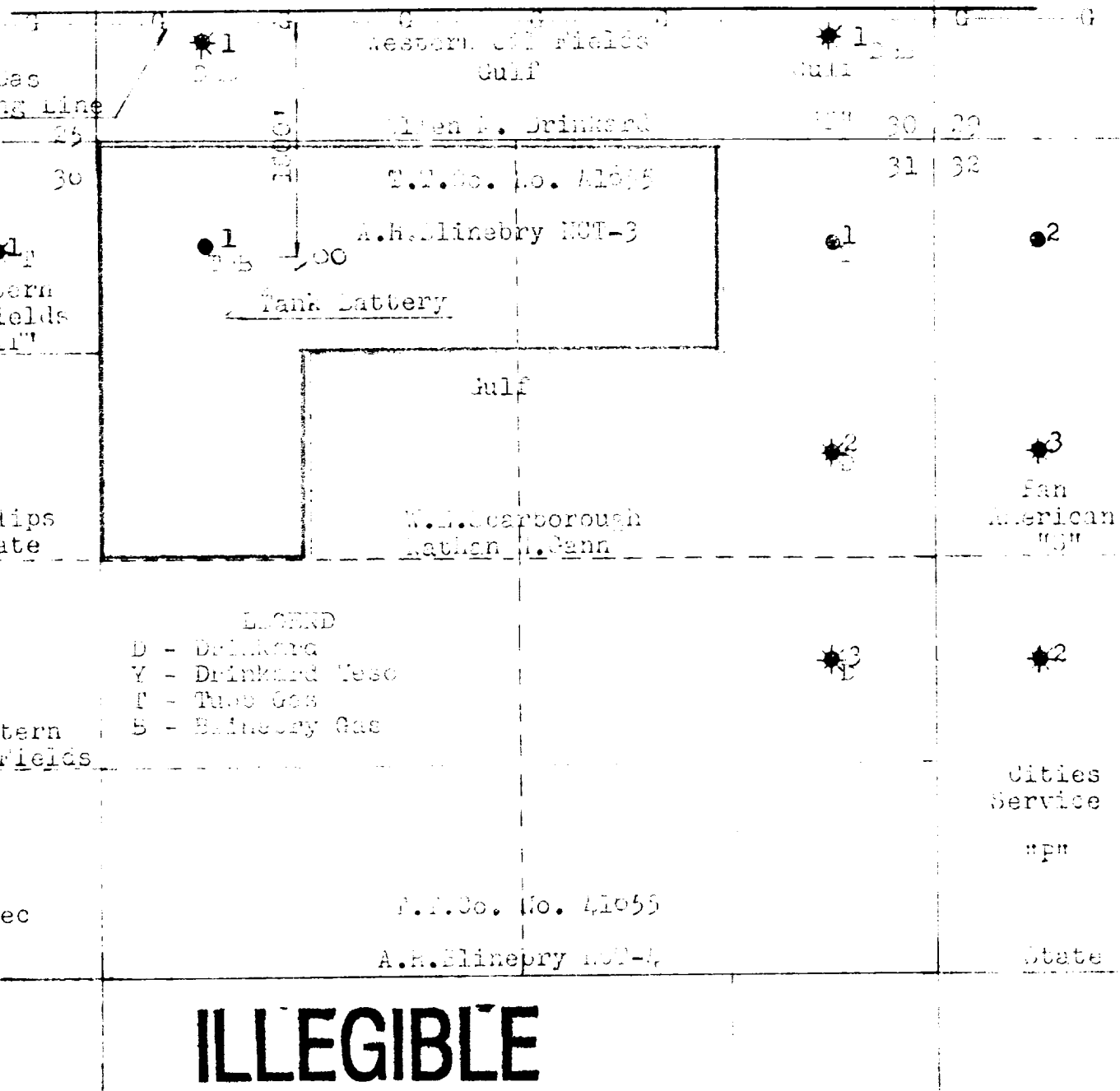
