
Gentlemen:

TEXACO Inc. completed the A. H. Blinebry (NCT-4) Well No. 1 as an oil-gas-oil triple completion in July, 1959, in the Drinkard, Tubb (Gas) and Blinebry (Oil) Pools, Lea County, New Mexico. The well was completed in a manner that provided for fluid flow from the Drinkard and Blinebry (Oil) through tubing with fluid flow from the Tubb (Gas) through the casing-tubing annulus.

By letter dated September 22, 1959, TEXACO Inc. was granted permission by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to produce the Tubb (Gas) from this well through the annulus for a 90-day period from the date of connection provided that multi-point back pressure tests be taken and reported to the Commission approximately 30 days and 60 days after date of connection.

In reply to a request from your office by telephone this date, this is to advise that TEXACO Inc. has not secured a Tubb (Gas) pipe line connection as yet; therefore, this zone has not been produced. After a gas connection is obtained we will submit the required tests as outlined in the Commission's letter mentioned above.
