This well was acidized with 10,000 gallons of acid and 1050 gallons of gel block in three stages: 1st stage-350 gallons of gel block and 3000 gallons of acid, 2nd stage-350 gallons of gel block and 3000 gallons of acid, 3rd stage-350 gallons of gel block and 4000 gallons of acid. The well was swabbed to clean up and natural flow was restored.
