Gentlemen:

It is respectfully requested that the Oil Conservation Commission grant an exception to No Flare Order R-553 as it pertains to Cities Service Oil Company's State "P" No. 2 in the Drinkard and Blinebry Oil Pools, Lea County, New Mexico. In support of this application, we wish to state the following:

1. Cities Service Oil Company is the owner and operator of the State "P" Lease, consisting of 120 acres and is comprised of the SE/4 of the NW/4 of Section 32-T22S-R38E and the W/2 of the SW/4 of Section 32-T22S-R38E. The State "P" No. 2 is located 1980' FSL and 660' FWL of Section 32-T22S-R38E and was completed on October 21, 1957.




