Dear Sir:

Gulf Oil requests your administrative approval for a 120 acre non-standard proration unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool, covering the S/2 NE/4 & NW/4 NE/4, Section 32, 22-S, 38-E, to be dedicated simultaneously to our T. R. Andrews well No. 1, located 660' FNL & 1980' FEL, and our T. R. Andrews well No. 2, located 1980' FN & EL, both in Section 32, 22-S, 38-E.

In support of this application the following facts are submitted:

1. The T. R. Andrews well No. 2 is a Blinebry Gas well with a 80 acre non-standard proration unit covering the S/2 NE/4 of said Section.
2. Effective January 1, 1972 our T. R. Andrews well No. 1 was reclassified, due to Gas-Oil ratio in excess of 32,000/1, as a gas well, resulting in two Blinebry gas wells in a single proration unit.
3. Rule 29 of the Blinebry Gas Field ^Rules permit two producing Blinebry gas wells within a single proration unit with the operator having the option to determine the proration of the assigned allowable to be produced by each well.
4. The attached plats show the proposed 120 acre unit outlined in red.
5. All offset operators have been furnished a copy of this application.

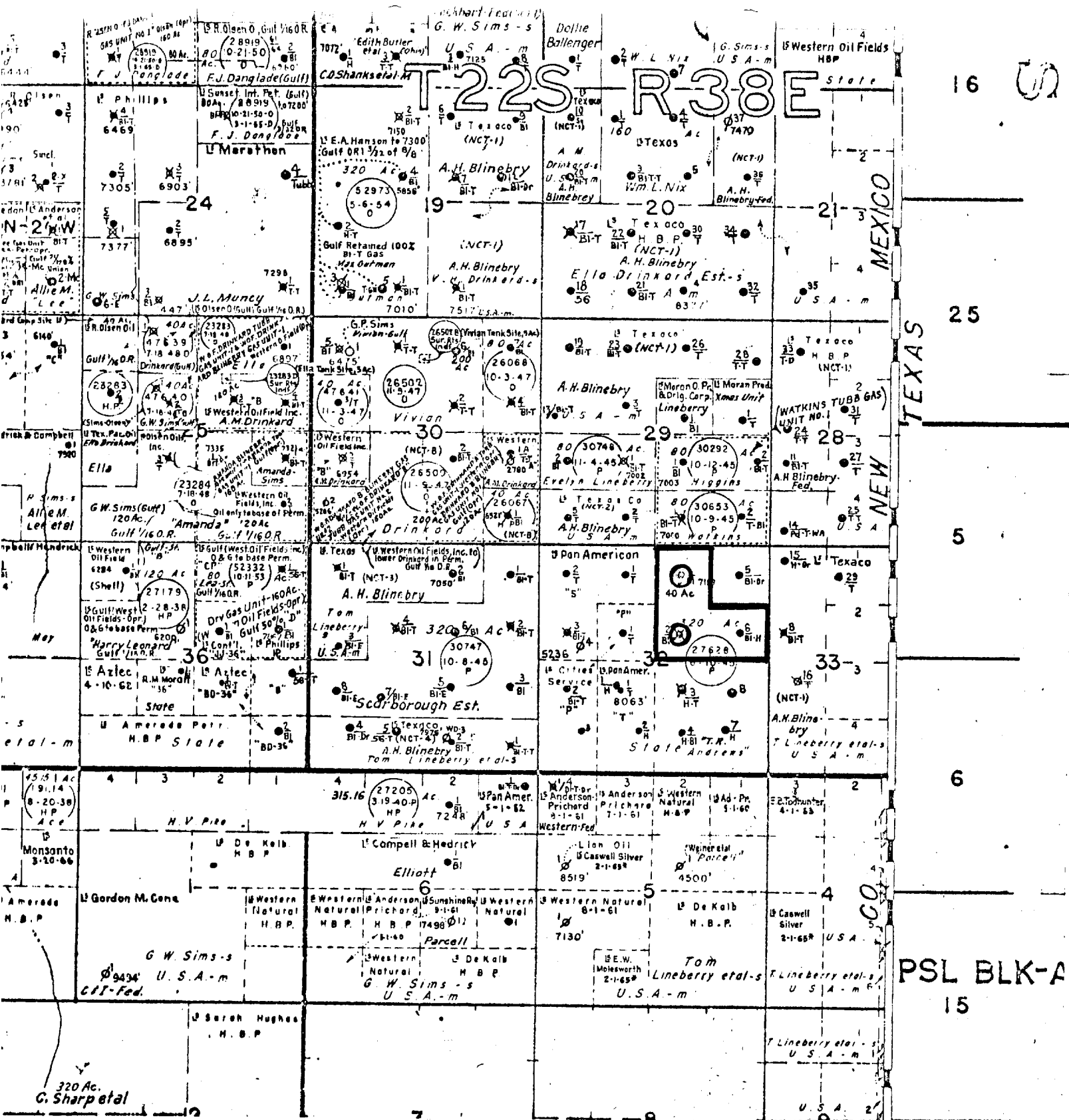
