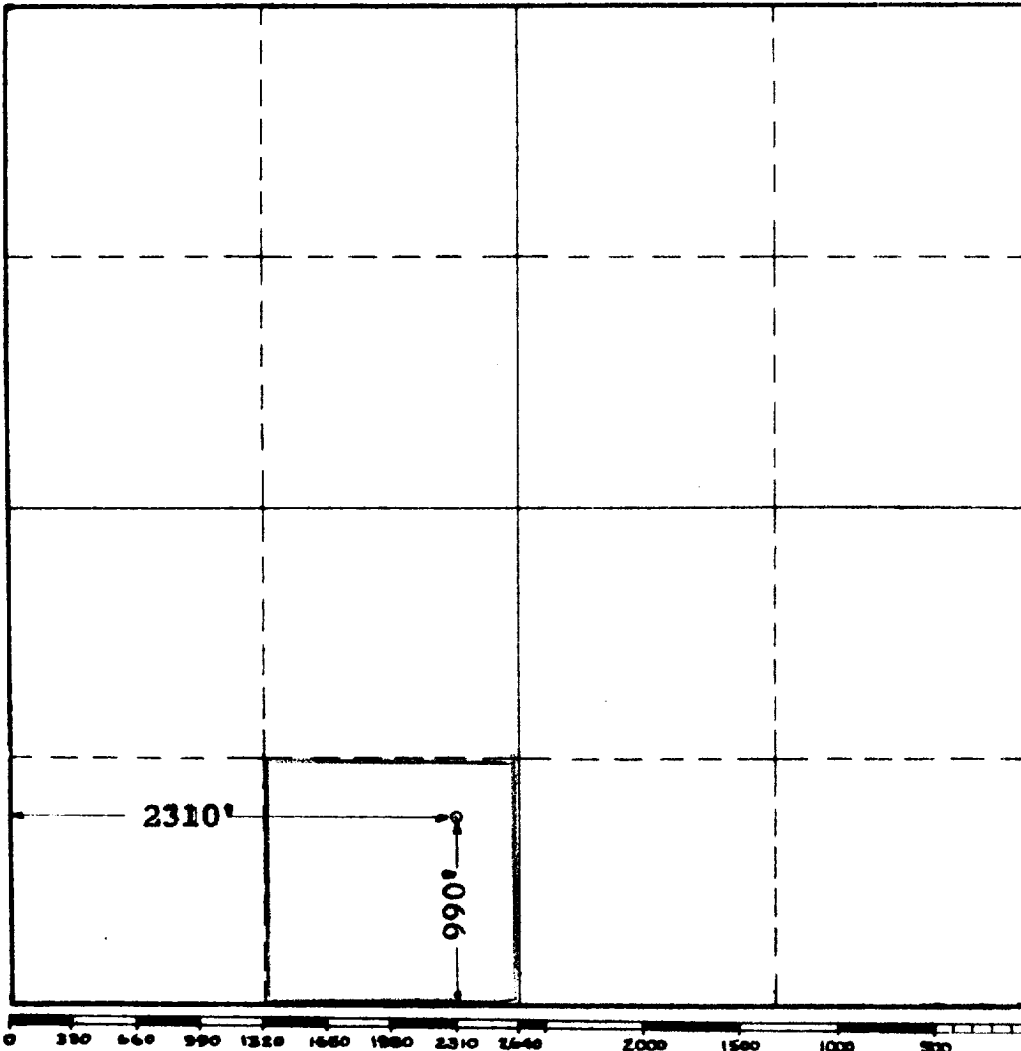

Gentlemen:

On May 26, 1958, a survey was made to locate your State "T" Oil Well No. 2, located 2310 feet from the west line and 990 feet from the south line of Section 32, Township 22 South, Range 38 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.

A flag was placed on the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner common to section 32 T 22 S, R 38 E, and section 5, T 23 S, R 38 E, a 1 inch Iron Pipe with Brass Cap. The transit was placed over the southwest corner of section 32, a 2 inch Iron Pipe with Brass Cap, and sighting to the flag on above $\frac{1}{4}$ corner, thus establishing a course of East, thence, along the south line of section 32, East, 2310 feet, Set 2 inch by 2 inch hub, from which the above $\frac{1}{4}$ corner bears East, 331.97 feet, thence North, 990 feet to proposed oil well site, set iron pin, from which reference stake bears 100 feet south, and from which reference stake bears 100 feet north, thence, South, 990 feet, to the 2 inch by 2 inch hub. No error found in chaining. Total chained distance from the corner to the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner was found to be 2641.97 feet.
