Following is a report on the work done and the results obtained under the heading noted above at the Stanolind Oil & Gas Co. State "N" Well No. 1 in the Company or Operator NE/4 of NW/4 of Sec. 32, T. 22-S, R. 30-E, N. M. P. M., Drinker-4-Yano Field, Lea County.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On July 19, 1945 at 8:00 PM, 38 hours had elapsed since setting 305 feet of 13" OD LW casing and cemented with 250 sacks to be used for surface string. At this time casing shut-off was tested as follows:

A pressure of 600 lbs. was built-up and held for one hour, and as shut-off was OK, the cement plug was drilled, and a pressure of 600 lbs. was again built-up and held for one hour. As this test, too, was OK, drilling operations were resumed.
