FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On June 11, 1946 at 1:35 p.m., approx. 24 hours will have elapsed since running 7-5/8" OD 24-26.4# New Casing in subject well and cementing with 500 sacks cement. This is to be used as intermediate string. At that time casing shut off will be tested in the following manner: A pressure of 750# will be built up and held for 30 minutes, and if test is OK, cement plug will be drilled and a pressure of 750# again built up and held for 30 minutes, if this test, too, is OK, drilling operations will be resumed.

Cement plug will be drilled out early after taking maximum pressure build-up, test and plug will be cored to determine feasibility of using Harris Method before drilling plug. Approval was given by phone by Mr. R. R. Spurrier, Oil Conservation Commission, Santa Fe, New Mexico.
