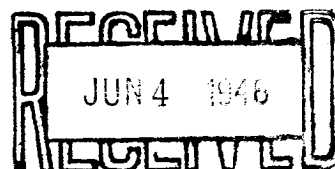

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 10 p.m. on May 29, 1946, 48 hours had elapsed since running 296' of 10 1/2" OD 40.5# and 45.5# SH Casing in subject well and cementing with 250 sacks cement. At this time casing was tested in the following manner:

A pressure of 750# was built up and held for thirty minutes. Cement plug was then drilled and a pressure of 750# was again built up and held for thirty minutes. Casing shut off tested OK and drilling was resumed.
