## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

At 10 p.m. on May 29, 1946, 48 hours will have elapsed since running 296' of 10 3/4" OD 40.5# and 45.5# SH Casing in subject well, and cementing with 250 sacks cement, to be used as surface string. At that time casing shut off will be tested as follows:

A pressure of 750# will be built up and held for thirty minutes, and if test is OK cement plug will be drilled, and a pressure of 750# again built up and held for thirty minutes, if this test, too, is okeh, drilling operations will be resumed.
