Under provisions of Order R-316, Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Stanolind Oil and Gas Company makes application for administrative approval to dually complete and produce its State "S" Well No. 3, SW/4 of NW/4 of Section 32, Township 22-S, Range 38-E, Lea County, New Mexico. This dual completion will be effected through the casing-tubing annulus, and gas from the Tubbs formation through the tubing by selective perforations and installation of suitable packer equipment.

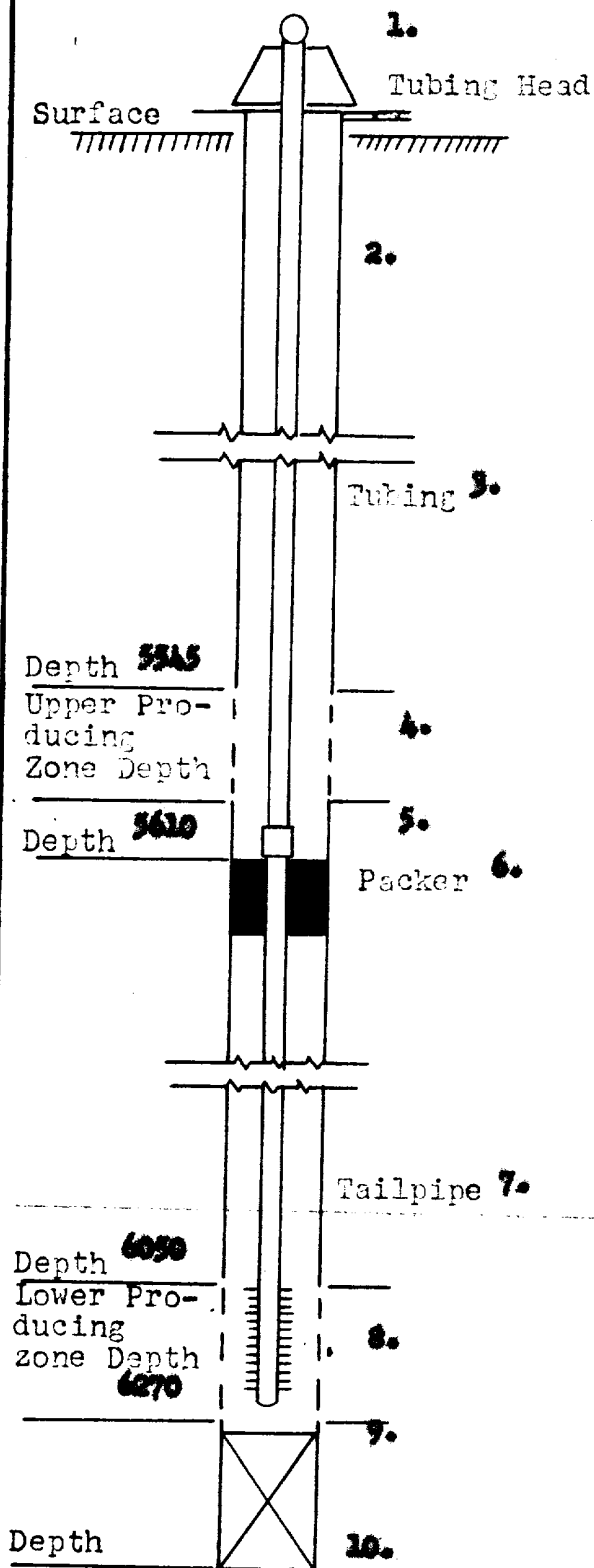
