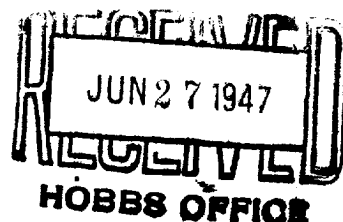

REPORTS ON WELLS

Submit this report in triplicate to the Oil Conservation Commission or its proper agent within ten days after the work specified is completed. It should be signed and sworn to before a notary public for reports on beginning drilling operations, results of shooting well, results of test of casing shut off, result of plugging of well, and other important operations, even though the work was witnessed by an agent of the Commission. Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public. See additional instructions in the Rules and Regulations of the Commission.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 12:00 P.M., June 19th, 1947, thirty hours had elapsed since setting 6866' of 7" OD new 20# and 23# casing as oil string in subject well and cementing with 600 sacks of cement. At the time mentioned above, casing shut-off was tested as follows:

A pressure of 1000# was built up and held for thirty minutes. This test was OK. Cement plug was drilled and a pressure of 1000# was built up again and held for thirty minutes. This test, too, was OK.
