DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On November 5, 1947 at 11:30 PM, 30 hours had elapsed since running 6881' of 5½" 17# J-55 Casing in subject well and cementing with 150 sacks, to be used on oil string. At this time casing shut off was tested as follows:
 A pressure of 1000# was built up and held for 30 minutes, and test being OK, cement plug was drilled and a pressure of 1000# again built up and held for 30 minutes. This test, too, being OK, completion operations were resumed.
