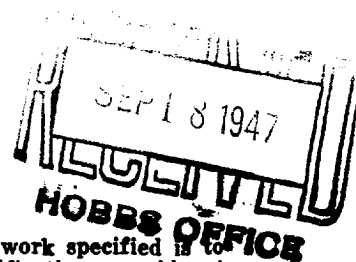

## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

## FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On Form C-101 dated July 16th, 1947, we indicated that subject well would be drilled to an approximate total depth of 7200 feet to test the Drinkard Pay. We now propose to drill to a total depth of 8500 feet to test the McKee Sands and Ellenburger. In the event these latter pays prove to be unproductive, well is to be plugged back to a depth of 7150 and completion made in the Drinkard Zone. Drill stem test made on September 7th from 6920 to 7150, indicated light production at this interval.
