DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 8:00 A.M., on August 7th, 1947, 24 hours had elapsed since running 7 5/8" O.D. new 26.4# casing and setting at 3001 feet, cementing with 900 sacks cement, to be used as intermediate string. At the time mentioned, casing shut-off was tested as follows:

A pressure of 1000# was built up and held for 30 minutes. This test was OK. Cement plug was drilled and a pressure of 1000# again built up and held for 30 minutes. This test, too, was OK. Drilling operations were resumed.
