## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 1:30 A.M., on July 27th, 1947, 24 hours had lapsed since running 13 3/8" O.D. new 36# Arneo casing and setting at 291 feet, cementing with 310 sacks cement, to be used as surface string. At the time mentioned, casing shut-off was tested as follows:

A pressure of 750# was built up and held for 30 minutes. Test was OK, cement plug was drilled and a pressure of 750# again built up and held for 30 minutes. This test, too, was OK, and drilling operations were resumed.
