INSTRUCTIONS

This certificate is prepared and filed by the OIL PRODUCER, the owner of the Office of the Oil Conservation Commission, or an authorized representative of the gas is produced. The certificate shall be filed in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission. After said certificate has been filed with the Oil Conservation Commission, the owner shall file a separate report of the certificate, a copy retained by the producer, and a copy retained by the Oil Conservation Commission.

A new certificate shall be filed to cover each change in operation of the oil or gas transport, to include transport except that in the case of a temporary transporter, the transporter shall file a new certificate to notify the Oil Conservation Commission of such change, and the transporter authorized by certificate of the Oil Conservation Commission, by letter of the estimated amount of oil or gas to be transported by the transporter to a property moving oil or gas from the unit and the transporter shall file a temporary transporter and a copy of such notice shall also be furnished to the transporter. Said temporary transporter shall not move any more oil or gas than the estimated amount shown in said notice.

This certificate is hereby properly executed and approved by the Oil Conservation Commission's rules constitute a permit for pipeline connection and for the transporter to transport oil and gas from the property named therein and shall be in full force and effect.

- (a) The transporter is changed or
- (b) The permit is cancelled by the Commission.

If any of the rules and regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission have not been complied with at the same time this report is filed, the transporter shall file the heading "REMARKS."

In all cases when this certificate is filed to cover a change in ownership or when the transporter designated to move oil or gas from the unit, the "REMARKS" section of the owner or operator and the transporter shall be authorized to transport oil or gas.

A separate report shall be filed to cover each production of oil or gas from the Oil Conservation Commission.
