INSTRUCTIONS

This permit shall be executed and filed in OIL AND GAS PERMITS, in the office of the Oil Conservation Commission, at a place where the oil or gas is produced, as shown in certificate, and by letter of authorization shall be authorized to transport the oil or gas from a unit. After said certificate has been filed with the Oil Conservation Commission, one copy shall be forwarded to the operator, one copy retained in the production, and two copies retained by the Oil Conservation Commission.

A new certificate shall be filed to cover each change in operation, and each change in the transportation, except that in the case of a temporary transporter moving less than the allowable production for one production unit, the operator shall, in lieu of filing a new certificate notify the Oil Conservation Commission, District Office, and the transporter authorized by certificate of the Commission, by letter of the estimated amount of oil or gas to be moved by the transporter temporarily moving oil or gas from the unit and the name of the temporary transporter and a copy of such notice shall also be furnished to the transporter. Said temporary transporter shall not move any more than the estimated amount shown in said notice.

This certificate when properly executed and approved by the Oil Conservation Commission shall constitute a permit for pipeline connection and shall authorize transport oil and gas from the property named therein and shall remain in full force and effect until:

- (a) The operating ownership changes;
- (b) The transporter is changed; or
- (c) The permit is cancelled by the Commission.

If any of the rules and regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission have not been complied with at the same time this report is filed, the permit shall be labeled "REMARKS."

In all cases where this certificate is filed to cover a change in ownership, the operator shall designate the transporter designated to move oil or gas from the "REMARKS" of the previous owner or operator and the transporter shall be authorized to transport oil or gas.

A separate report shall be filed to cover each production unit authorized by the Oil Conservation Commission.
